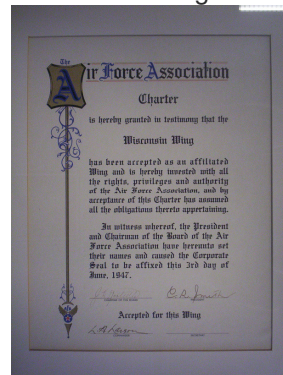

The August meeting is the cookout (catered by the All Ranks Club) and the December meeting is our Christmas Party.

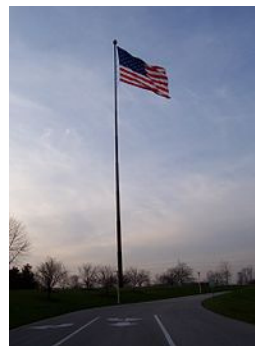
Chapter News

The United States Air Force Academy

On April 1, 1954, President Dwight D. Eisenhower signed into law the bill authorizing the establishment of the United States Air Force Academy, dedicated to the motivation and training of career officers for the Air Force. On April 1, 1979, the 25th anniversary of the United States Air Force Academy was observed. From 1959 through 1978, there have been 315 Wisconsin Cadets graduated. So on April 1, 1979, Governor Lee Sherman Dreyfus, proclaimed this a special day of observance.

On April 1, 2014, the Air Force Academy celebrated its 60th anniversary.

CADET HONOR CODE

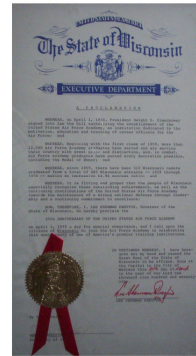
This oath remains unchanged since its adoption in 1984 and consists of a statement of the code, followed by a resolution to live honorably:
