#### 'Spirit of 45' – the 70<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the end of WWII

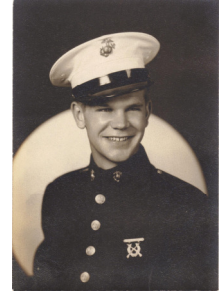

The WWII Veterans present and honored were Gottlieb Schafer and Del Breckenridge. Also honored were 11 other veterans who have passed. Flowers provided by the chapter were placed at the Veterans Cemetery in Union Grove.

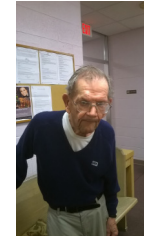
