CYBER PATRIOT

Air Force Association's CyberPatriot works. Some important highlights of the 2016 Student and Alumni Survey:

Higher education places of current high school students: 77% of the surveyed high school students indicated they will pursue or 2- or 4-year education in either cybersecurity (18.8%), computer science (31%), or another STEM field (27.7%).

Fields of study for CyberPatriot alumni enrolled in high education program: A full 87.5% of the alumni respondents currently pursuing higher education degrees are doing so in a cybersecurity (24.5%), computer science (34.7%) or other STEM field (28.3%), compared to the national average of only 14.2% of students pursuing STEM degrees.

Current career fields for high school graduates: 82.4% of high school graduates are employed or are looking for jobs in a cybersecurity or computer science field. An additional 9% are employed or looking for jobs in another STEM field.

Round 1 competition began November 11. Round 2 began December 11. Participants received a T-Shirt, challenge coin, lapel pin, stylus pen, charging cables, participating certificate, and a Cyber Bullying Booklet.
